Megawide Foundation helps bring free bus rides to commuters

The Foundation supports JCISP and the Department of Transportation in Serbus, a project that brings free bus rides to commuters travelling from Monumento, Lawton, and Baclaran to Parañaque.

Manila, Philippines – Junior Chamber International Senate Philippines (JCISP), with the support of Megawide Corporate Foundation, Inc. (Megawide Foundation) and the Department of Transportation (DOTr), today formally launched Serbus: A Service to Humanity. The event was held at the Andres Bonifacion Shrine in Ermita, Manila.

Serbus will provide free bus rides for commuters from Monumento, Lawton, and Baclaran going to Parañaque, with the Parañaque Integrated Terminal Exchange (PITX) as the final drop-off point. 6 bus units are servicing the route Monday to Friday, 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. The service, which started last January 9, 2019, will run for six months.

“Megawide Foundation is proud to partner with JCISP and the Department of Transportation in bringing free bus rides to commuters via Serbus,” said Sheila Lynn Nawata, Megawide Foundation Chief Operating Officer. “We support projects that actively promote the wellbeing of Filipinos. Through Serbus, we are able to provide safe and accessible means of travel for hundreds of commuters that take this route on a daily basis.”

The event was attended by members of JCISP led by its President, Domingo Roque, Jr., DOTr Usec. Mark de Leon, and other members of Government.
