Cubao, Quezon City – Today, engineering and infrastructure conglomerate Megawide and leading Filipino developer Araneta Center Inc. (ACI) celebrated the topping-off ceremony of the New Gateway at the height of 31.31 meters.

The New Gateway mall has a construction floor area of more than 120,000 square meters. It will be a 7-storey building with structural elements, such as beams, slabs, and walls, built with a combination of Megawide’s precast and formwork technologies. Megawide’s proprietary precast technology is used to expedite construction without sacrificing engineering quality.
