Update on GMCAC's Alleged Violation of Anti-Dummy Law

Megawide Construction Corporation (Megawide) received information that Warrants of Arrest have been issued by the Regional Trial Court of Lapu-Lapu City (RTC) against the Directors of Megawide's airport subsidiary, GMR MEGAWIDE Cebu Airport Corporation (GMCAC), for the alleged violation of the Anti-Dummy Law. This is a procedural step to acquire jurisdiction over the persons of the said Directors, and is being addressed with the posting of bail.

Megawide and GMR, through GMCAC, transformed the Mactan-Cebu International Airport into the Philippines' only internationally-acclaimed and award-winning airport, and have done so through a firm adherence with all applicable laws, rules, and regulations, particularly as both are widely-held publicly-listed companies.
